Methodology and Evaluation

- Blended methodology: guided readings, synchronous/asynchronous classes, intensive workshops, supervised pastoral practice.
- Continuous evaluation: written assignments, pastoral projects, critical essays, presentations, supervised practice, and final project defense.
- In the bilingual modality, linguistic competencies in both Spanish and English will be evaluated according to institutional standards.
